

F. SPECIAL SERVICES

1. Forwarding remains to another funeral home

This charge includes the removal, Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, Embalming, necessary authorizations, motor equipment to point of transportation and a proportionate share of overhead costs. This charge does **not** include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body. The cost of selected merchandise, shipping container and transportation fees must be **added** to the below forwarding fee. This service is at times arranged for and charged to the receiving funeral home.

- A. With minimum shipping container **\$ 1,755.00**
With Casket selected at funeral home **\$ 1,570.00**
(in addition to the cost of the casket)
- B. Air Tray (Required by Airlines to ship Casket) **\$ 150.00**
- C. Combination Casket—Shipping Tray **\$ 185.00**

2. Receiving remains from another funeral home

This charge includes temporary shelter of the remains, the transportation of the remains to cemetery or crematory and the basic services of staff. It does **not** include visitation, funeral rites or ceremonies. **\$ 975.00**

3. Immediate burials

Our charge for immediate burial, without any attendant rites or ceremonies, includes removal and shelter of remains, local transportation to the cemetery, necessary services of staff, and authorizations.

- A. Immediate burial with merchandise **\$ 1,235.00**
provided by the purchaser.
- B. Immediate burial with cloth covered casket **\$ 2,130.00**
- C. Immediate burial with casket selected from **\$ 1,235.00**
our funeral home, **plus** the cost of the casket.

4. Direct Cremation

Our charge for direct cremation includes removal and shelter of remains, local transportation to the crematory, necessary authorizations and the Basic Services of funeral director and staff. This charge does **not** include the crematory fee, Medical Examiner's fee or the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private prior to cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composite materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we can provide are unfinished wood boxes and fiberboard boxes.

5. Anatomical Donation / Cremation

This charge includes the removal, Basic Services **\$ 1,325.00**
of funeral director and staff, embalming, and
necessary authorizations and permits for the receiving
medical facility. This charge does **not** include visitation,
rites or ceremonies prior to transportation. The cost of
transportation must be **added** to the above.

OUR CREDIT POLICY

Payment Policy— Total Funeral Bill:

We are a small independent business providing services and merchandise and are totally dependent upon our clients for prompt payment. Therefore, payment is requested at the time arrangements are made.

When monies are not readily available or guaranteed to us for funeral expenses and merchandise, evidence of financing and payment must be given prior to the time of the funeral being scheduled and/or announced. If an insurance policy is assigned to us as payment, there will be a \$150.00 filing fee **added** to the funeral services and merchandise selected for processing and handling the account.

Under circumstances where the Estate of the deceased will bear full responsibility for paying the funeral expenses, a late payment penalty of 1.5% per month (18% per annum) will be charged until the Estate is opened. We will also charge a \$350.00 estate filing fee in **addition** to the funeral services and merchandise selected.

If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

ITEMIZED SELECTIONS

A. BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR & STAFF \$ 1,275.00

Our basic service charge includes, but is not limited to: Staff to respond to initial request for service; Arrangement conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral or other disposition; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; coordination with third parties providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory and others. Also included in this charge are the overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expenses.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding and receiving remains.)

B. EMBALMING \$ 395.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as, direct cremation or immediate burial.

a. Alternate Care \$ 295.00

If embalming is declined, alternate care will provide for the disinfection, shelter and refrigeration of the remains until final disposition takes place.

- 1. Reconstructive restoration when necessary \$ 125.00
- 2. Special care of autopsied remains \$125.00
- 3. Washing and disinfecting of un-embalmed body. \$125.00
- 4. Cosmetology, dressing and placement of deceased in casket. \$125.00

b. Funeral Service at another facility: \$ 425.00

Our services include coordinating and supervision of the funeral service and additional staff necessary to conduct funeral services at another facility.
